Areas include: inflatable bouncy jumps, henna tattoo area (very popular with students), spa area, set-up (which is during the day), and general assignments.
- **Parent Security: DADS** - PLEASE volunteer to assist the hired security and Scottsdale Police to make sure that students are safe and complying with rules set forth in PPG guidelines (which students agreed to by signing prior to the event). Parent security volunteers usually roam the event. If there is a problem, volunteers will contact either a hired security officer or one of the 3 police officers on site. We need approx. 15 security volunteers.
